

# SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5510

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
3 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**  
4 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**  
5 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Consumer**  
6 **and Business Services for the following purposes:**

- 8 **Board ..... \$ 28,217,938**
- 9 (2) **Workers’ Compensation**
- 10 **Division ..... \$ 49,148,715**
- 11 (3) **Oregon OSHA..... \$ 50,644,667**
- 12 (4) **Health Insurance Marketplace.. \$ 15,850,553**
- 13 (5) **Central Services Division..... \$ 50,859,275**
- 14 (6) **Division of Financial**
- 15 **Regulation..... \$158,988,103**
- 16 (7) **Building Codes Division ..... \$ 43,826,925**

17 “**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
18 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**  
19 **of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Consumer and**  
20 **Business Services for the following purposes:**

- 21 (1) **Oregon OSHA..... \$ 13,457,541**
- 22 (2) **Health Insurance Marketplace.. \$ 1,813,619**
- 23 (3) **Central Services Division..... \$ 356,604**
- 24 (4) **Building Codes Division ..... \$ 29,152**
- 25 (5) **Division of Financial**
- 26 **Regulation..... \$104,441,874**

27 “**SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the following expenditures by the**  
28 **Department of Consumer and Business Services are not limited:**

- 29 “(1) **Expenditures from the Workers’ Benefit Fund;**
- 30 “(2) **Expenditures from the Self-Insured Employer Adjustment Reserve;**
- 31 “(3) **Expenditures from the Self-Insured Employer Group Adjustment Reserve;**
- 32 “(4) **Expenditures from the Consumer and Business Services Fund for payment of con-**  
33 **tracted collection costs, including contracted processing costs for the Combined Payroll Tax**  
34 **Reporting System and workers’ compensation paying agent reimbursements as described in**  
35 **ORS 656.307;**

1       “(5) Expenditures from the Funeral and Cemetery Consumer Protection Trust Fund; and  
2       “(6) Special payments to Oregon Health and Science University for research on occupa-  
3       tional illness and disease.

4       “SECTION 4. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
5       peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect  
6       July 1, 2021.”.

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
