A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5513

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for certain biennial expenses.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for distribution as grants-in-aid, for program costs and to purchase services.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for debt service on general obligation bonds.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to department for deposit in High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Fund.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from certain fees, moneys or other revenues collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain federal funds.

Limits biennial expenditures by department for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from certain federal funds received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from certain fees, moneys or other revenues collected or received by department. Limits biennial expenditures by department from specified accounts. Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.
