

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5513

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 23

1       On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 21 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:

2       “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium  
3 beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following  
4 purposes:

- 5       (1) Operations..... \$   107,368,314  
6       (2) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$    14,315,702

7       “**SECTION 2.** There are appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium  
8 beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, which are to be dis-  
9 tributed as grants-in-aid, for program costs and to purchase services, for the following pur-  
10 poses:

- 11       (1) Early intervention services  
12             and early childhood special  
13             education programs ..... \$   216,112,910  
14       (2) Other special education  
15             programs..... \$    64,538,611  
16       (3) Other K-12 grant-in-aid  
17             programs..... \$    63,730,129  
18       (4) Oregon prekindergarten  
19             program ..... \$   163,141,727  
20       (5) Other early learning  
21             programs..... \$   113,400,753  
22       (6) Youth development programs \$    14,707,168

23       “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding ORS 327.856, there is appropriated to the Department of  
24 Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of  
25 \$174,618,343 for deposit in the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness  
26 Fund.

27       “**SECTION 4.** There is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium  
28 beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$48,238,961 for debt service  
29 on general obligation bonds.

30       “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
31 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment  
32 of expenses, other than expenses described in sections 6 and 14 of this 2021 Act, from fees,  
33 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds,  
34 corporate activity tax funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of  
35 Education, for the following purposes:

- 1 (1) Capital bonding ..... \$ 150,000,000
- 2 (2) Operations..... \$ 61,315,968
- 3 (3) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$ 6,598,468

4 “SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
 5 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment  
 6 of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from fees, moneys or other revenues,  
 7 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, corporate activity tax funds  
 8 and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education for programs other  
 9 than those specified in sections 5 and 14 of this 2021 Act, for the following purposes:

- 10 (1) Early learning programs..... \$ 12,360,701
- 11 (2) Youth development programs \$ 6,331,117
- 12 (3) Educator Advancement  
 13 Council ..... \$ 50,375,000
- 14 (4) All other grants ..... \$ 399,988,681

15 “SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
 16 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment  
 17 of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in sections 8 and 14 of this 2021  
 18 Act, collected or received by the Department of Education, for the following purposes:

- 19 (1) Operations..... \$ 156,608,600
- 20 (2) Oregon School for the Deaf.. \$ 329,420

21 “SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
 22 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment  
 23 of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services from federal funds, other than those  
 24 described in sections 7 and 14 of this 2021 Act, received by the Department of Education, for  
 25 the following purposes:

- 26 (1) Early learning programs..... \$ 210,204,580
- 27 (2) Youth development programs \$ 1,255,179
- 28 (3) Early learning COVID-19  
 29 related grants ..... \$ 473,755,776
- 30 (4) K-12 COVID-19 related  
 31 grants..... \$ 1,202,777,506
- 32 (5) All other grants ..... \$ 898,952,162

33 “SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
 34 \$892,276,973 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for  
 35 payments of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Ed-  
 36 ucation from the Student Investment Account established under ORS 327.175.

37 “SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following  
 38 amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for  
 39 payments of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Ed-  
 40 ucation from the Early Learning Account established under ORS 327.269, for the following  
 41 purposes:

- 42 (1) Early intervention services  
 43 and early childhood special  
 44 education programs ..... \$ 83,800,510
- 45 (2) Other early learning

1            programs..... \$ 348,136,610

2            **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
3 \$4,169,563 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for  
4 payment of expenses by the Department of Education from the Early Learning Account es-  
5 tablished under ORS 327.269 for operations.

6            **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following  
7 amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for  
8 payments of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased services by the Department of Ed-  
9 ucation from the Statewide Education Initiatives Account established under ORS 327.250, for  
10 the following purposes:

- 11            (1) High School Graduation and  
12            College and Career  
13            Readiness Fund..... \$ 136,682,685
- 14            (2) Reengagement program ..... \$ 8,344,000
- 15            (3) Statewide equity initiatives... \$ 22,688,000
- 16            (4) All other grants ..... \$ 167,230,199

17            **“SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
18 \$35,956,536 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for  
19 payment of expenses by the Department of Education from the Statewide Education Initi-  
20 atives Account established under ORS 327.250 for operations.

21            **“SECTION 14.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the following expenditures by the  
22 Department of Education are not limited:

23            **“(1)** Moneys from the School Lunch Revolving Account, Education Training Revolving  
24 Account and Common School Fund; and

25            **“(2)** Expenditures for grants-in-aid and purchased services from federal funds received  
26 by the Department of Education from the United States Department of Agriculture.

27            **“SECTION 15.** This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect  
29 July 1, 2021.”.

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
