

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5515

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 Delete lines 5 through 26 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated to the State Department of Energy, for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$80,092 for oversight of ra-
4 dioactive waste disposal.

5 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
6 \$31,011,546 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
7 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
8 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Department
9 of Energy.

10 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
11 \$3,022,570 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
12 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-
13 nomic Development Fund to the State Department of Energy for debt service for the energy
14 efficiency and sustainable technology loan program, and for the public schools grant pro-
15 gram.

16 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
17 \$3,123,736 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
18 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Department of
19 Energy.

20 “**SECTION 5.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the following expenditures by the
21 State Department of Energy are not limited:

22 “(1) Expenditures for loans for small scale local energy projects; and

23 “(2) Expenditures for debt service.

24 “**SECTION 6.** This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect
26 July 1, 2021.”
