Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- Fee for license to practice naturopathic medicine, prorated according to receipt: Annual active license renewal..... \$ 350 (b) Applications received January 1 **350** through March 31 ..... \$ (c) Applications received April 1 275 through June 30......\$ (**d**) Applications received July 1 through September 30..... \$ 200
- through December 31.....\$ 125 Fee for change of status,

**Applications received October 1** 

inactive license to active ...... \$ 350

SECTION 2. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.
