## Senate Bill 5525

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## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 23 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect 24 July 1, 2021.
