

Senate Bill 5525

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Approves certain new or increased fees adopted by Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

- (1) **Fee for license to practice naturopathic medicine, prorated according to receipt:**
 - (a) **Annual active license renewal \$ 350**
 - (b) **Applications received January 1 through March 31 \$ 350**
 - (c) **Applications received April 1 through June 30..... \$ 275**
 - (d) **Applications received July 1 through September 30..... \$ 200**
 - (e) **Applications received October 1 through December 31..... \$ 125**
- (2) **Fee for change of status, inactive license to active \$ 350**

SECTION 2. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.
