

Enrolled Senate Bill 5539

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of State Lands; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in section 2 of this 2021 Act, collected or received by the Department of State Lands, for the following purposes:

- (1) **Common School Fund**
programs..... \$ 40,779,060
- (2) **Submerged Lands**
Enhancement Fund..... \$ 200,000
- (3) **South Slough National**
Estuarine Research
Reserve operations..... \$ 2,642,051
- (4) **Capital improvements**..... \$ 549,056
- (5) **Oregon Wetlands**
Revolving Fund..... \$ 2,048,739

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$5,249,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Portland Harbor Cleanup Fund established by ORS 274.064.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands for the following purposes:

- (1) **South Slough National**
Estuarine Research
Reserve operations..... \$ 2,738,001
- (2) **Common School Fund**
programs..... \$ 195,954

SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Department of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges, unclaimed property finders fees and State Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are not limited.

SECTION 5. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.
