6	or received by the Department of State Lands, for the following purposes:

17	"SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
18	\$5,249,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for
19	payment of expenses by the Department of State Lands from the Portland Harbor Cleanup
20	Fund established by ORS 274.064.
21	"SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
22	are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment
23	of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands for
24	the following purposes:
25	(1) South Slough National
26	Estuarine Research
27	Reserve operations \$ 2,738,001
28	(2) Common School Fund
29	programs \$ 195,954
30	"SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Department
31	of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges, unclaimed property finders fees and State
32	Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are not limited.
33	"SECTION 5. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect

July 1, 2021.".
