

# SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5542

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 2

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** (1) There is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for the  
3 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$18,371,940 for debt  
4 service on the State Radio Project and highway improvement projects.

5 “(2) There is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for the biennium begin-  
6 ning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$14,400,000 for expenses related to  
7 debris removal associated with the 2020 wildfire season.

8 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
9 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment  
10 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-  
11 eral funds received as reimbursement from the United States Department of Transportation,  
12 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or re-  
13 ceived by the Department of Transportation, for the following purposes:

- 14 (1) Capital improvement..... \$ 18,099,880
- 15 (2) Maintenance and emergency
- 16 relief programs ..... \$ 744,121,732
- 17 (3) Preservation program..... \$ 446,173,142
- 18 (4) Bridge program..... \$ 494,371,408
- 19 (5) Operations program..... \$ 435,669,414
- 20 (6) Modernization program..... \$ 141,646,624
- 21 (7) Special programs..... \$ 537,365,821
- 22 (8) Local government program... \$ 303,079,658
- 23 (9) Driver and motor vehicle
- 24 services ..... \$ 256,458,783
- 25 (10) Commerce and compliance ... \$ 77,673,013
- 26 (11) Policy, data and analysis ..... \$ 194,455,898
- 27 (12) Public transit ..... \$ 258,808,502
- 28 (13) Rail..... \$ 51,398,601
- 29 (14) Transportation safety ..... \$ 17,949,645
- 30 (15) Support services ..... \$ 179,751,268
- 31 (16) ODOT headquarters ..... \$ 61,914,340
- 32 (17) Finance and budget..... \$ 52,429,763
- 33 (18) Debt service ..... \$ 400,357,130

34 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
35 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment

1 of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2021 Act, col-  
2 lected or received by the Department of Transportation, for the following purposes:

- 3 (1) Driver and motor  
4 vehicle services..... \$ 2,204,752
- 5 (2) Commerce and compliance ... \$ 8,000,000
- 6 (3) Policy, data and analysis ..... \$ 201,769
- 7 (4) Public transit..... \$ 76,886,503
- 8 (5) Rail..... \$ 17,122,916
- 9 (6) Transportation safety ..... \$ 21,270,051
- 10 (7) Finance and budget..... \$ 317,204

11 **“SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
12 \$125,155,188 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for  
13 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-  
14 nomic Development Fund to the Department of Transportation for debt service.

15 **“SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
16 \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for  
17 payment of expenses by the Department of Transportation from lottery moneys allocated  
18 from the Veterans’ Services Fund established under ORS 406.140 to the Department of  
19 Veterans’ Affairs and transferred to the Department of Transportation for veteran transit  
20 services.

21 **“SECTION 6.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Department  
22 of Transportation from federal funds for debt service on Build America Bonds are not lim-  
23 ited.

24 **“SECTION 7.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures by the Department  
25 of Transportation from the Oregon Transportation Infrastructure Fund established under  
26 ORS 367.015 for debt service and for internally reimbursed expenditures are not limited.

27 **“SECTION 8.** This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
28 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect  
29 July 1, 2021.”.
