Senate Bill 592

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits person from using lead weight in waters of this state for purpose of angling or commercial fishing. Provides that violation is punishable by maximum of 364 days' imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

Prohibits person from using lead shotgun pellet for purpose of hunting. Provides that violation is punishable by maximum of 364 days' imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A person may not use a lead weight in the waters of this state for the

5 purpose of angling or commercial fishing.

6 (2) A person that violates subsection (1) of this section commits a Class A misdemeanor.

7 SECTION 2. (1) A person may not use a lead shotgun pellet for the purpose of hunting.
