

# Senate Bill 636

Sponsored by Senator HANSELL (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that when state agency is required by statute to mail notice to person, and agency has on file post office box address for person, agency must mail notice to post office box address.

2 Relating to mailing of notices.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Whenever an agency of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, is re-**  
5 **quired by statute to mail a notice to a person, and the agency has on file a post office box**  
6 **address for the person, the agency shall mail the notice to the post office box address.**
