Senate Bill 654

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits performance of late-term sex-selective abortion.

| 10 | Whereas Oregonians strongly believe in gender equality; and |
| 11 | Whereas sex-selective abortions deprive unborn children of their natural rights to life, liberty |
| 12 | and the pursuit of happiness as described in the Declaration of Independence and as protected by |
| 13 | the United States Constitution; now, therefore, |
| 14 | Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: |
| 15 | SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "late-term sex-selective abortion" means an |
| 16 | abortion performed during the third trimester of pregnancy and undertaken solely because |
| 17 | of the known or suspected sex of the unborn child. |
| 18 | (2) A person may not perform a late-term sex-selective abortion in this state. |
