## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 713

"SECTION 1. (1) Except as otherwise required by law, a public or private post-secondary
institution of education may not require a prospective student to disclose whether the pro-
spective student has a criminal conviction before the institution makes a final decision on
whether to admit the prospective student.
"(2) Any materials or websites that are created by a public or private post-secondary
institution of higher education and that are routinely used by prospective students when
deciding whether to apply for admission to a particular course, program, major or degree

pathway at the institution must include a notification to prospective students if the institution has determined that the particular course, program, major or degree pathway is likely

to lead to professional licensure requirements that may exclude individuals with criminal
