PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2264

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "alcohol;" delete the rest of the line and insert "creating new provisions; and amending ORS 471.130.".

3 Delete lines 4 through 10 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. Sections 2 and 3 of this 2021 Act are added to and 5 made a part of ORS chapter 471.

6 "SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 471.175, an Indian tribe that 7 holds a full on-premises sales license may purchase distilled liquor for 8 sale by the drink within Indian country directly from the Oregon Li-9 quor Control Commission at a price negotiated by the Indian tribe and 10 the commission. As used in this section, 'Indian country' has the 11 meaning given that term in 18 U.S.C. 1151.

12 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 471.175, an airline described in 13 ORS 471.182 that holds a full on-premises sales license may purchase 14 distilled liquor for sale to ticketed passengers aboard a commercial 15 aircraft directly from the Oregon Liquor Control Commission at a 16 price negotiated by the airline and the commission.

(1) [All licensees and permittees of the Oregon Liquor Control ¹⁹ Commission,] Before selling or serving **an** alcoholic [liquor] **beverage** to any ²⁰ person about whom there is any reasonable doubt of the person's having ²¹ reached 21 years of age, **a licensee or permittee** shall require [such] **the** 1 person to produce one of the following pieces of identification:

2 "(a) The person's passport issued by the United States or a foreign gov-3 ernment.

"(b) The person's motor vehicle operator's license issued by this state or
another state of the United States or a province or territory of Canada.

6 "(c) An identification card issued under ORS 807.400.

7 "(d) A United States military identification card.

8 "(e) An identification card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe.

9 "(f) Any other identification card issued by a state or territory of the 10 United States or province or territory of Canada that bears a picture of 11 the person, the name of the person, the person's date of birth and a physical 12 description of the person.

"(g) Proof of the person's participation in the Secure Electronic Network for Travelers Rapid Inspection program operated by United States Customs and Border Protection, the NEXUS program jointly operated by that agency and the Canada Border Services Agency, or a successor to either of those programs that is recognized by the **Oregon Liquor Control** Commission.

"(h) Any other form of identification as defined by the commission by rule.

"(2) If a person does not have identification as described in subsection (1) of this section, the permittee or licensee shall require [*such*] **the** person to make a written statement of age and furnish evidence of the person's true age and identity. The written statement of age shall be on a form furnished or approved by the commission, including but not limited to the following information:
