## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 554

- On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 21, insert:
- "SECTION 1a. (1) Any entity that adopts an ordinance or policy under section 1 of this 2021 Act limiting or precluding the use of the affirmative defense described in ORS 166.370 (3)(g), concerning the possession of firearms by persons licensed to carry a concealed handgun under ORS 166.291 and 166.292, in a public building under the control of the entity is strictly liable for any harm resulting from a violent event that occurs on or near the premises of the public build-

- "(2) The following persons may bring a cause of action under this section:
- "(a) A person who is a victim of the violent event; and
- 13 "(b) A person who is personally acquainted with a victim of the vi-14 olent event.
- 15 "(3) In an action under this section, the defendant is liable unless 16 the defendant proves, beyond a reasonable doubt, that the plaintiff has 17 not suffered any harm as a result of the violent event.
- 18 "(4) Upon prevailing in an action under this section, the plaintiff 19 may recover the greater of:
- 20 "(a) Actual economic and noneconomic damages; or
  - "(b) Statutory damages of \$100,000 per plaintiff.

- "(5)(a) ORS 30.260 to 30.300 do not apply to claims under this section.
- "(b) A claim under this section is not subject to the limitation imposed by ORS 31.710.
- 5 "(6) As used in this section:
- 6 "(a) 'Economic damages' has the meaning given that term in ORS 7 31.710.
- 8 "(b) 'Noneconomic damages' has the meaning given that term in 9 ORS 31.710.
- "(c) 'Public building' has the meaning given that term in ORS 166.360.
- 12 "(d) 'Victim' means:
- "(A) A person injured or killed as a result of the violent event; or
- "(B) A witness to the violent event.".
