**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2931**

1 Delete lines 6 through 10 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. (1) A person who arrests another person pursuant to**  
3 **the authority described in ORS 133.225, 133.235, 133.239 or 133.245 shall**  
4 **ensure that the arrested person receives a medical assessment at the**  
5 **time of arrest or as soon as practicable after arrest.**

6 **“(2) This section does not apply to tribal police officers or tribal law**  
7 **enforcement agencies when:**

8 **“(a) The arrest is made in Indian country or on tribal lands; or**

9 **“(b) The arrest is performed in connection with a matter under the**  
10 **criminal or civil jurisdiction of a tribe.**

11 **“(3) As used in this section, ‘medical assessment’ means a physical**  
12 **examination by or under the direction of a licensed physician, physi-**  
13 **cian assistant or nurse practitioner.”.**
