## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 563

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 31 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
- 3 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 418.726 is amended to read:
- 4 "418.726. (1) There is created a Youth Suicide Intervention and Prevention
- 5 Advisory Committee to advise the Oregon Health Authority on the develop-
- 6 ment and administration of strategies to address suicide intervention and
- 7 prevention for children and youth [10 through] who are 24 years of age or
- 8 younger. The Director of the Oregon Health Authority shall appoint mem-
- 9 bers of the advisory committee and members shall serve at the pleasure of
- the director. The authority shall provide staffing for the advisory committee.
- 11 "(2) The director shall ensure that advisory committee membership re-
- 12 flects the cultural, linguistic, geographic and economic diversity of this
- state. The members of the advisory committee must include, but need not be
- 14 limited to:
- "(a) Individuals who have survived suicide attempts;
- "(b) Individuals who have lost friends or family members to suicide;
- "(c) Individuals who have not attained 21 years of age;
- "(d) Representatives of state agencies, including but not limited to the
- 19 Department of Human Services, the Oregon Health Authority and the De-
- 20 partment of Education, who provide services to individuals who have not
- 21 attained 21 years of age;

- "(e) Representatives of Oregon Indian tribes;
- 2 "(f) Representatives of colleges and universities;
- 3 "(g) Medical and behavioral treatment providers;
- 4 "(h) Representatives of hospitals and health systems;
- 5 "(i) Representatives of coordinated care organizations and private insur-6 ers;
- 7 "(j) Suicide prevention specialists; and
- 8 "(k) Representatives of members of the military and their families.
- "(3) Members of the advisory committee other than members employed in 9 full-time public service may be compensated for their services and may be 10 reimbursed by the authority for the member's actual and necessary expenses 11 incurred in the performance of the member's duties. Members of the advisory 12 committee who are employed in full-time public service may be reimbursed 13 by the member's employing agency for the member's actual and necessary 14 expenses incurred in the performance of the member's duties. Reimburse-15 ments under this subsection are subject to the provisions of ORS 292.210 to 16 292.288. 17
- 18 "(4) The advisory committee shall meet no less than once every three months.
- 20 "(5) The advisory committee may recommend potential members for appointment to the advisory committee.
- "(6) The advisory committee shall consult with the Youth Suicide Intervention and Prevention Coordinator on updates to the Youth Suicide Intervention and Prevention Plan under ORS 418.733.
- "SECTION 2. ORS 418.731 is amended to read:
- <sup>26</sup> "418.731. (1) As used in this section and ORS 418.733:
- "(a) 'Youth' means a person [10 through] who is 24 years of age or younger.
- "(b) 'Youth suicide' means a completed or attempted suicide by a person [10 through] who is 24 years of age or younger.

- "(2) There is established a Youth Suicide Intervention and Prevention Coordinator within that part of the Oregon Health Authority that works with mental health and addiction issues. The coordinator shall:
- "(a) Facilitate the development of a statewide strategic Youth Suicide
  Intervention and Prevention Plan to address youth suicide and youth selfinflicted injury, and develop strategies for intervention with suicidal, depressed and at-risk youth;
- 8 "(b) Improve outreach to special populations of youth that are at risk for 9 suicide and self-inflicted injury;
- "(c) Identify barriers to accessing intervention services for suicidal, depressed and at-risk youth; and
- "(d) Provide technical assistance to state and local partners and coordinate interagency efforts to establish youth suicide and youth self-inflicted injury prevention and intervention strategies.
  - "(3) The coordinator shall review data and prepare an annual report to interim and regular committees of the Legislative Assembly with subject matter jurisdiction over child welfare, mental health and addiction issues, and to the Oregon Health Authority, regarding:
- "(a) The number of emergency room admissions for completed and attempted youth suicides and incidents of youth self-inflicted injury;
  - "(b) The manner and method of completed and attempted youth suicides and incidents of youth self-inflicted injury;
  - "(c) The counties in which the completed and attempted suicides and self-injury incidents occurred;
- 25 "(d) The number of middle schools and high schools with completed youth 26 suicides among the student body;
- "(e) The number of completed youth suicides where the youth had previously been admitted to a hospital or emergency room for treatment of attempted youth suicide or self-inflicted injury or had been the subject of a request for intervention services related to depression, suicidal ideation or

- self-injury within the prior 12 months;
- 2 "(f) Demographic information regarding youth who completed or at-
- 3 tempted youth suicide or who had self-injury incidents, including but not
- 4 limited to:
- 5 "(A) Age;
- 6 "(B) Gender;
- 7 "(C) Race;
- 8 "(D) Primary spoken language;
- 9 "(E) Sexual orientation;
- "(F) The existence of any physical, mental, intellectual or emotional dis-
- 11 ability; and
- "(G) Foster care status; and
- "(g) Recommendations for administrative and legislative changes to ad-
- 14 dress service gaps in youth suicide prevention, intervention and post-suicide
- activities, developed in consultation with the Youth Suicide Intervention and
- 16 Prevention Advisory Committee established in ORS 418.726.
- "SECTION 3. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate
- 18 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
- declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage.".
