1 Delete lines 5 through 22 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the State Department of
Geology and Mineral Industries, for the biennium beginning July 1,
2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$5,986,843 for operations
of the department.

"SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 6 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 7 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, 8 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-9 eral funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and fed-10 eral funds not described in this section, collected or received by the 11 State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries, for the following 12 purposes: 13

14 "(1) Geologic survey...... \$ 2,648,281

15 "(2) Mined land reclamation \$ 4,221,055

16 "SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 17 the amount of \$5,927,333 is established for the biennium beginning July 18 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal 19 funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2021 Act, collected 20 or received by the State Department of Geology and Mineral Indus-21 tries. "SECTION 4. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.".
