PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2786

- In the printed bill, delete lines 13 through 15 and insert:
- "SECTION 2. (1) The State Department of Agriculture shall:
- "(a) Study barriers for family-scale meat producers pertaining to slaughter waste disposal systems, the composting of slaughter waste and the disposal of dead livestock, including barriers arising from laws and rules; and
 - "(b) Recommend legislative or regulatory avenues to remove any barriers identified under paragraph (a) of this subsection, facilitate disposal of dead livestock by family-scale meat producers and promote access to rendering facilities by family-scale meat producers.
 - "(2) The department shall submit a report concerning the study and recommendations required by subsection (1) of this section, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to an appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.
 - "SECTION 3. There is appropriated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$50,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of sections 1 and 2 of this 2021 Act.".
 - In line 16, delete "3" and insert "4".
