PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2850

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Sections 2 to 4 of this 2021 Act are added to and made
a part of ORS chapter 401.

4 "SECTION 2. (1) After the termination of a state of emergency de-5 clared under ORS 401.165, the Governor may establish one or more 6 economic recovery zones within the state for the purpose of promoting 7 economic stabilization and development within geographic areas af-8 fected by the emergency.

9 "(2) When establishing an economic recovery zone under this sec10 tion, the Governor shall:

"(a) Identify the geographic boundaries of the economic recovery
 zone;

"(b) Appoint a director to exercise the powers authorized in section
3 of this 2021 Act with respect to the economic recovery zone; and

"(c) Appoint an advisory board, including representatives from ge ographically appropriate public, private and non-profit sector organ izations, that is responsible for issuing recommendations to the
 director.

"(3) The director of an economic recovery zone shall, as soon as is
 practicable, appoint an incident management team under the control
 of the director. The incident management team shall develop and

manage recovery systems aligned with the National Disaster Recovery
 Framework established by the Federal Emergency Management
 Agency.

4 "(4) The director and the members of the incident management 5 team serve at the pleasure of the Governor. The Governor may fix the 6 compensation of the director and members of the incident manage-7 ment team. Such compensation is payable from moneys appropriated 8 or otherwise made available to the Office of the Governor.

9 "(5) At least once every 60 days during the existence of an economic
10 recovery zone, the director shall prepare and publish a report on
11 actions taken pursuant to sections 2 and 3 of this 2021 Act.

"SECTION 3. (1) During the existence of an economic recovery zone
 established under section 2 of this 2021 Act:

"(a) The director of the economic recovery zone may exercise any
 powers that the Governor is authorized to exercise during an emer gency declared under ORS 401.165.

"(b) The director may require state agencies not to enforce rules
 or statutes with respect to actions taken or projects carried out under
 the direction of the director to further the purpose of the economic
 recovery zone.

"(c) A local government shall approve an application for the development or use of land for any action or project that is approved by the director on any property, notwithstanding ORS chapter 195, 197, 197A, 215 or 227 or any statewide plan, rule of the Land Conservation and Development Commission or local land use regulation, zoning ordinance, regional framework plan, functional plan or comprehensive plan, if the action or project:

²⁸ "(A) Will comply with applicable building codes;

"(B) Will not result in the development of a new building that is
 sited within an area designated under a statewide planning goal re-

lating to natural disasters and hazards, including flood plains or
 mapped environmental health hazards, unless the development com plies with regulations directly related to the hazard; and

"(C) Will not pose any unreasonable risk to public health or safety.
"(d) The director shall publish a written justification for any exercise of authority under this section within 30 days of such exercise.
The explanation may be made part of the periodic report required under section 2 of this 2021 Act.

9 "(e) The Governor, by executive order, shall take actions necessary
10 to ensure the efficient and effective functioning of an economic re11 covery zone.

"(2) An approval under subsection (1)(c) of this section is not a land
 use decision and is subject to review only under ORS 34.010 to 34.100.

"(3) A rule or statute waived under subsection (1)(b) of this section
may not be enforced after the termination of the economic recovery
zone with respect to an action or project for which the rule or statute
was waived.

18 "SECTION 4. (1) An economic recovery zone established under sec-19 tion 2 of this 2021 Act is terminated 24 months after its establishment, 20 unless terminated earlier pursuant to this section. An economic re-21 covery zone may be terminated by order of the Governor or by joint 22 resolution of the Legislative Assembly.

"(2) Before the termination of an economic recovery zone, the duration of the economic recovery zone may be extended by up to 24 additional months by order of the Governor, if the Legislative Assembly concurs by joint resolution to such extension. The duration of an economic recovery zone may be extended only once under this subsection.".

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
