**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2398**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 9, delete “Except as provided in para-  
2 graphs (b) and (c) of this subsection.”.

3 In line 22, delete the second “and”.

4 In line 24, delete the period and insert “; and

5 “(E) Adopt the residential provisions of the Reach Code at the same time  
6 the director adopts a corresponding residential specialty code, and adopt the  
7 commercial provisions of the Reach Code at the same time the director  
8 adopts a structural specialty code.”.

9 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert:

10 “(c) If a municipality adopts the Reach Code and requires adherence to  
11 the Reach Code as a minimum construction standard and method, measure-  
12 ment of energy efficiency savings and related incentives must remain subject  
13 to the requirements of statewide residential and commercial codes. Notwith-  
14 standing the provisions of this paragraph, adoption of the Reach Code does  
15 not affect determinations of cost-effectiveness and payment of incentives  
16 under ORS 757.054 and 757.612.”.
