PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 702

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "standards" insert a period and delete the rest of the line.
- 3 Deletes lines 4 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1) No later than December 31, 2025, the State Board of Education shall review the social studies standards for kindergarten through grade 12.
- "(2) As part of the review required under subsection (1) of this section, the board shall consult with any combination of the following but must include at least one person who is:
- "(a) A public school student in any grade from grade 9 through 12;
- 11 "(b) A person who graduated from a public high school in 2015 or 12 any subsequent year;
- 13 "(c) A public school teacher in any grade from grade 9 through 12;
- 14 "(d) An education advocate;
- 15 "(e) A voting rights advocate;
- 16 "(f) A representative of a culturally specific organization; and
- 17 "(g) A representative of the Department of Education.
- "(3) When conducting the review, the board shall consider emphasizing civics education and making more accessible instruction related to:
- 21 "(a) Voting rights and how to vote;

- "(b) Current and historical social movements; and
- "(c) The roles of local governments and tribal governments.".

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
