PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 337

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "policy;" delete the rest of the line and insert "amending ORS 527.650.".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 527.650 is amended to read:
- 5 "527.650. (1) The State Board of Forestry shall establish a forest practice 6 committee for each forest region established pursuant to ORS 527.640.
- "(2) Each [such] committee shall consist of nine members, a majority of
 whom must reside in the region. Members of each committee [shall] must
 be qualified by education or experience in natural resource management
 [and] or conservation.
- "(3) To each committee, the board shall appoint:
- "(a) [Not less than two-thirds of the members of each committee shall be]

 At least five persons who are private landowners, private timber owners
 or authorized representatives of [such] private landowners or timber owners
 who regularly engage in operations.
- 16 "(b) At least one person who is employed by, or serves on the board 17 of, a nonprofit organization that promotes conservation and addresses 18 forestry issues.
- "(c) In addition to the person described in paragraph (b) of this subsection, at least one person who serves on the board of an Oregon forest collaborative, if the region for which the committee is estab-

1 lished has a forest collaborative.

- "[(2)] (4) The board shall appoint members of [forest practice] the committees [shall be appointed by the board] for three-year terms. If there is a vacancy for any cause, the board shall make an appointment to become immediately effective for the unexpired term.
- "(5) Each [such] committee shall select a chairperson from among its
 members. The State Forester shall designate a staff member of the State
 Forestry Department [shall be designated by the State Forester] to serve as
 the secretary, without voting power, for each [such] committee.".
