**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2334**

1 On page 5 of the printed bill, delete lines 40 through 45.

2 On page 6, delete lines 1 through 18 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 183.336 is amended to read:

4 “183.336. (1) The statement of cost of compliance effect on small busi-
5 nesses required by ORS 183.335 (2)(b)(E) **or (5)(e)** must include:

6 “(a) An estimate of the number of small businesses subject to the proposed
7 rule and identification of the types of businesses and industries with small
8 businesses subject to the proposed rule;

9 “(b) A brief description of the projected reporting, recordkeeping and
10 other administrative activities required for compliance with the proposed
11 rule, including costs of professional services;

12 “(c) An identification of equipment, supplies, labor and increased admin-
13 istration required for compliance with the proposed rule; *[and]*

14 “(d) A description of the manner in which the agency proposing the rule
15 involved small businesses in the development of the rule; **and**

16 **“(e) A finding as to whether a rule will have a significant adverse
17 effect upon small businesses.**

18 “(2) An agency shall utilize available information in complying with the
19 requirements of this section.

20 **“(3) If the statement of cost of compliance effect on small busi-
21 nesses shows that a rule has a significant adverse effect upon small**

1 **business, to the extent consistent with the public health and safety**
2 **purpose of the rule, the agency shall reduce the economic impact of**
3 **the rule on small business by:**

4 **“(a)(A) Establishing differing compliance or reporting requirements**
5 **or timetables for small business;**

6 **“(B) Clarifying, consolidating or simplifying the compliance and**
7 **reporting requirements under the rule for small business; and**

8 **“(C) Utilizing objective criteria for standards;**

9 **“(b) Exempting small businesses from any or all requirements of**
10 **the rule; or**

11 **“(c) Adopting a less intrusive or less costly rule applicable to small**
12 **business.”.**
