PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 335

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "Forestry;" delete the rest of the line and insert "creating new provisions; and amending ORS 526.009.".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 526.009 is amended to read:
- 5 "526.009. (1) There is created a State Board of Forestry consisting of seven
- 6 members appointed by the Governor. The members appointed to the board
- 7 shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate as provided in ORS 171.562
- 8 and 171.565. The Governor shall designate one member of the board as
- 9 chairperson to hold that position until that member's term expires or until
- relieved by the Governor as provided in subsection [(6)] (5) of this section.
- 11 The chairperson shall have such powers and duties as are provided by the
- 12 rules of the board.
- "(2) The term of office of a member of the board is four years. A member
- shall be eligible for reappointment, but no member shall serve more than two
- consecutive full terms. In case of a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall
- make an appointment as provided in subsection (1) of this section.
- 17 "(3) Appointments made by the Governor under subsection (1) of this
- section shall include appointment of at least one member from each of the
- 19 forest regions established under ORS 527.640 and the rules adopted there-
- 20 under by January 1, 1987.

"(4) [No more than three members of the board may derive any significant

- 1 portion of their income directly from persons or organizations that are subject
- 2 to regulation under ORS 527.610 to 527.770, 527.990 (1) and 527.992.] Not
- 3 more than two members of the board may have derived income of
- 4 \$10,000 or more, in any of the five years preceding the member's ap-
- 5 pointment to the board, from forestry enterprises or primary timber
- 6 products-processing enterprises. If the board includes two members
- 7 described in this subsection, at least one of the two members must
- 8 have derived the income described in this subsection exclusively from
- 9 enterprises on woodlands of not more than 5,000 acres.
 - "[(5) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, no member of the
- board shall have any relationship or pecuniary interest that would interfere
- with the member representing the public interest.]
- "[(6)] (5) The Governor may at any time remove any member of the board
- 14 for inefficiency, incompetence, neglect of duty, malfeasance in office, unfit-
- 15 ness to render effective service or failure to continue to meet the criteria
- of appointment pursuant to this section.
- "SECTION 2. All members of the State Board of Forestry who are
- 18 serving on the board on the effective date of this 2021 Act may con-
- 19 tinue to serve on the board until the end of their terms. On or after
 - the effective date of this 2021 Act, the Governor may not make an
- 21 appointment or reappointment that is inconsistent with ORS 526.009,
- as amended by section 1 of this 2021 Act.".
