- 9 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert:
- "(c) If a municipality adopts the Reach Code and requires adherence to
 - the Reach Code as a minimum construction standard and method, measure-
- ment of energy efficiency savings and related incentives must remain subject
- to the requirements of statewide residential and commercial codes. Notwith-
- standing the provisions of this paragraph, adoption of the Reach Code does

- 16 under ORS 757.054 and 757.612.".
