**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3355**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 26 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. As used in sections 2 and 3 of this 2021 Act:**

3 **“(1) ‘Crowd management’ means a public security practice in which**
4 **large crowds of 50 persons or more are managed to prevent the out-**
5 **break of crowd crushes, affrays, fights or riots.**

6 **“(2) ‘Law enforcement agency’ means the Oregon State Police, a**
7 **county sheriff’s office, a municipal police department or a police de-**
8 **partment established by a university under ORS 352.121 or 353.125.**

9 **“(3) ‘Law enforcement officer’ means a member of the Oregon State**
10 **Police, a sheriff or deputy sheriff, a municipal police officer or a police**
11 **officer commissioned by a university under ORS 352.121 or 353.125.**

12 **“SECTION 2. (1) A law enforcement officer who is on duty and as-**
13 **signed to work crowd management in a city with a population of over**
14 **150,000 shall have:**

15 **“(a) The officer’s first initial and last name, or a unique identifier**
16 **assigned by the officer’s law enforcement agency, affixed to the front**
17 **of the officer’s uniform;**

18 **“(b) The officer’s first initial and last name, or a unique identifier**
19 **assigned by the officer’s law enforcement agency, affixed to the back**
20 **of the officer’s uniform;**

21 **“(c) If wearing a tactical helmet and assigned a unique identifier**

1 by the officer's law enforcement agency, the unique identifier affixed
2 to the back of the officer's helmet;

3 “(d) The name of the jurisdiction of the officer's law enforcement
4 agency and the word ‘POLICE,’ ‘SHERIFF’ or ‘TROOPER’ on the front
5 and back of the officer's uniform; and

6 “(e) A patch signifying the officer's law enforcement agency affixed
7 to one shoulder.

8 “(2) The information required under subsection (1) of this section
9 shall be affixed in a manner that makes the letters and numbers
10 clearly visible.

11 “(3) A law enforcement agency shall adopt a policy prohibiting the
12 intentional obscuring by a law enforcement officer of any of the in-
13 formation required under subsection (1) of this section.

14 “(4) This section does not apply to members of the Oregon State
15 Police.”.
