**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 235**

1 Delete lines 4 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Corrections shall develop a plan**
3 **for providing the equipment, connectivity and infrastructure necessary**
4 **to ensure that adults in custody, in the Coffee Creek Correctional Fa-**
5 **ility and the Snake River Correctional Institution, have online access**
6 **to:**

7 **“(a) The adult basic skills development program described in ORS**
8 **421.084;**

9 **“(b) The professional and technical program described in ORS**
10 **421.081; and**

11 **“(c) Education programs that provide college credit, a college de-**
12 **gree, a college certification, an industry-recognized certification or li-**
13 **cence or an apprenticeship.**

14 **“(2) The department shall submit the plan developed under this**
15 **section, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to an interim com-**
16 **mittee of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than**
17 **December 31, 2021.**

18 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2,**
19 **2023.**

20 **“SECTION 3. No later than September 1, 2022, the Department of**
21 **Corrections shall ensure that adults in custody, in the Coffee Creek**

1 **Correctional Facility and the Snake River Correctional Institution,**
2 **have online access to:**

3 **“(1) The adult basic skills development program described in ORS**
4 **421.084;**

5 **“(2) The professional and technical program described in ORS**
6 **421.081; and**

7 **“(3) Education programs that provide college credit, a college de-**
8 **gree, a college certification, an industry-recognized certification or li-**
9 **cence or an apprenticeship.**

10 **“SECTION 4. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
11 **date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative**
12 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
