2023.

 have online access to:

"(1) The adult basic skills development program described in ORS

5 "(2) The professional and technical program described in ORS 6 421.081; and

"(3) Education programs that provide college credit, a college degree, a college certification, an industry-recognized certification or license or an apprenticeship.
