**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2021**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon delete the rest of the line  
2 and insert: “amending ORS 469A.210.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 469A.210 is amended to read:

5 “469A.210. (1) The Legislative Assembly finds that community-based  
6 renewable energy projects, including but not limited to marine renewable  
7 energy resources that are either developed in accordance with the Territorial  
8 Sea Plan adopted pursuant to ORS 196.471 or located on structures adjacent  
9 to the coastal shorelands, are an essential element of this state’s energy fu-  
10 ture.

11 “(2) For purposes related to the findings in subsection (1) of this section,  
12 by the year 2025, at least eight percent of the [*aggregate electrical capacity*  
13 *of all electric companies that make*] **electrical generation of each electric**  
14 **company that makes** sales of electricity to 25,000 or more retail electricity  
15 consumers in this state must be composed of electricity generated by one or  
16 both of the following sources:

17 “(a) Small-scale renewable energy projects with a generating capacity of  
18 20 megawatts or less that generate electricity utilizing a type of energy de-  
19 scribed in ORS 469A.025; or

20 “(b) Facilities that generate electricity using biomass that also generate  
21 thermal energy for a secondary purpose.

1       “(3) Regardless of the facility’s nameplate capacity, any single facility  
2 described in subsection (2)(b) of this section may be used to comply with the  
3 requirement specified in subsection (2) of this section for up to 20 megawatts  
4 of [*capacity*] **generation.**”

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
