- "(D) A car bed, crib mattress or bassinet mattress;
- 15 "(E) A carriage, basket, dressing table, stroller, playpen, infant carrier,
- lounge pad, crib bumper or other product manufactured for young children
- or the pad for a product described in this subparagraph;
- 18 "(F) A water bed, an air mattress or another product that contains liquid-
- or gas-filled ticking and that does not contain upholstery material between
- 20 the ticking and the mattress core; or
- 21 "(G) A foldout sofa bed, futon, futon mattress or upholstered furniture.".

- On page 5, delete lines 37 through 41 and insert:
- "(j) Provide a mechanism to mitigate the costs associated with collection 16 and management of discarded mattresses that are illegally dumped. The pro-17 posed mechanism must take into account the cost of one or more incentives 18 to encourage collectors to properly dispose of discarded mattresses and dis-19 courage illegal dumping, and may include but need not be limited to pro-20 posals for funding of cleanup activities, for education and outreach or for 21 studies to evaluate the causes of illegal dumping. The proposed mechanism 22 may not require the stewardship organization or collectors to enter private 23 property without authorization from the property owner or other appropriate 24 authority.". 25

- "(b) A plan may provide for methods for providing convenient service that are alternative methods to those provided for in paragraph (a) of this subsection if, based on a geographic information systems analysis or additional information, the alternative methods will result in providing service to resi-

- 3 section.".

- 7 ously approved plan, the department may require the stewardship organiza-
- 8 tion to submit an amendment under subsection (1) of this section, regardless
- 9 of whether the change has been implemented.".

- Delete lines 33 through 41 and insert:
- 13 "(b) Information on the number and tonnage of discarded mattresses col-
- lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program during the previous
- calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to determine how the
- program is performing in different regions of the state;
- "(c) Information on the number and tonnage of program mattresses col-
- lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program for recycling during the
- 19 previous calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to determine
- 20 how the program is performing in different regions of the state;
- "(d) Information on the number and tonnage of program mattresses col-
- 22 lected pursuant to the mattress stewardship program for renovation during
- 23 the previous calendar year at a sufficient level of disaggregation to deter-
- 24 mine how the program is performing in different regions of the state;".
- On page 10, delete lines 6 through 11 and insert:
- 26 "(h) The number of discarded mattresses received through collection that
- 27 were not program mattresses, the number of discarded mattresses that were
- 28 illegally dumped as reported to the department, an analysis of how the data
- 29 required by this paragraph has changed over time and strategies the
- 30 stewardship organization will take to address discarded mattresses that are

- 1 not program mattresses and discarded mattresses that are illegally
- 2 dumped;".
- In line 27, delete "and foundations".
- On page 11, line 12, delete "four" and insert "five".
- In line 16, delete "four" and insert "five".
- On page 13, lines 10 through 12, delete the boldfaced material.
