- "(C) 'Goods or services' does not include insurance, except as provided in

- "(2)(a) A person that brings an action under subsection (1) of this section
- 2 shall mail a copy of the complaint or other initial pleading to the Attorney
- 3 General at the time the action commences and, upon entry of any judgment
- 4 in the action, shall mail a copy of the judgment to the Attorney General.
- 5 Failure to mail a copy of the complaint is not a jurisdictional defect, but a
- 6 court may not enter judgment for the plaintiff until proof of mailing is filed
- 7 with the court. Proof of mailing may be by affidavit or by return receipt of
- 8 mailing.
- 9 "(b) A person that brings an action under ORS 646.608 (1)(bbbb) shall mail
- 10 a copy of the complaint or initial pleading, and of any judgment the court
- 11 enters, to the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business
- 12 Services.".

- On page 9, delete line 1
- In line 2, restored the bracketed material and delete the boldfaced mate-

- "SECTION 8. A prosecuting attorney may not take action under
- 20 ORS 646.618 or 646.632 with respect to an act or practice declared un-
- 21 lawful under ORS 646.608 (1)(bbbb) unless the Director of the Depart-
- 22 ment of Consumer and Business Services first requests the prosecuting
- 23 attorney to take action. The director may elect to be named as a party
- 24 in any action or proceeding that the prosecuting attorney commences
- 25 at the director's request.
- 26 "SECTION 9. Section 8 of this 2021 Act and the amendments to ORS
