**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 636**

1 Delete lines 4 through 6 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law,**
3 **whenever an agency of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**
4 **is required by statute to mail to an individual a notice containing in-**
5 **formation specifically pertinent to the individual, and the agency has**
6 **on file a post office box address for the individual, the agency shall**
7 **mail the notice to the post office box address if that address is the**
8 **individual’s last known address on file with the agency or the address**
9 **to which the individual has requested in writing that notices be sent.**

10 **“(2) A notice mailed to a post office box address under this section**
11 **that meets any other requirements for service by mail is complete and**
12 **adequate service by mail.**

13 **“(3) An agency’s failure to comply with the requirements of this**
14 **section does not invalidate a notice mailed to an address other than**
15 **a post office box address if the notice was received by the individual.**

16 **“(4) If an agency of state government has multiple divisions that**
17 **keep addresses on file, subsection (1) of this section applies separately**
18 **to each division of the agency that keeps addresses on file.”.**
