PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 702

1 Deletes lines 4 through 19 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) No later than December 31, 2025, the State Board
of Education shall review the social studies standards for kindergarten
through grade 12.

5 "(2) As part of the review required under subsection (1) of this 6 section, the board shall consult with any combination of the following 7 but must include at least one person who is:

8 "(a) A public school student in any grade from grade 9 through 12;

9 "(b) The parent of a public school student in any grade;

"(c) A person who graduated from a public high school in 2015 or
 any subsequent year;

12 "(d) A public school teacher in any grade from grade 9 through 12;

13 "(e) An education advocate;

14 "(f) A voting rights advocate;

16 "(h) A representative of the Department of Education.

"(3) When conducting the review, the board shall consider empha sizing civics education and making more accessible instruction related
 to:

- 20 "(a) Voting rights and how to vote;
- 21 "(b) Current and historical social movements;

"(c) The roles of local governments and tribal governments; and
"(d) The United States Constitution, the Oregon Constitution and
the constitutional form of government in this country.".
