**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3127**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “recovery” insert “; and declaring an
2 emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$1,800,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
6 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
7 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
8 ministrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for the
9 Panther Creek Water Tank Replacement project.**

10 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$15,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
12 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
13 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
14 Administrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for the
15 Panther Creek Septic and Stormwater project.**

16 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
17 the amount of \$60,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
18 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
19 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
20 Administrative Services for distribution to Marion County for sewer
21 and septic repair and replacement.**

1 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
2 **the amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
3 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
4 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
5 **ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Detroit for the**
6 **Permanent Drinking Water System project.**

7 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
8 **the amount of \$7,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
9 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
10 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
11 **ministrative Services for distribution to the unincorporated commu-**
12 **nity of Blue River for septic repair and replacement and for**
13 **wastewater improvements.**

14 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
15 **the amount of \$20,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning**
16 **July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-**
17 **tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Department of Envi-**
18 **ronmental Quality for the Onsite Septic Repair and Replacement Loan**
19 **Program to support communities impacted by wildfire.**

20 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
21 **the amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
22 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
23 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
24 **ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Talent, City of**
25 **Ashland and City of Phoenix for fire flow water line upgrades.**

26 **“SECTION 8. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
27 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
28 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
29 **General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to Lincoln**
30 **County for well repair.**

1 **SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
2 **the amount of \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
3 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
4 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
5 **ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for Mount**
6 **Hood pump stations and installing permanent generators.**

7 **SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
8 **the amount of \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
9 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
10 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
11 **ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Estacada for the**
12 **Pump Station project.**

13 **SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
14 **the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
15 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
16 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
17 **ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Talent for water**
18 **reservoir replacement to ensure adequate fire flow.**

19 **SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
20 **the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
21 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
22 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
23 **ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Glide for Water**
24 **Association upgrades.**

25 **SECTION 13. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
26 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
27 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
28 **General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to the City of**
29 **Phoenix for Charlotte Ann Water District Disbanding Transition costs.**

30 **SECTION 14. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**

1 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
2 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
3 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to Jackson
4 County and Douglas County for Private Water System Assistance.

5 **“SECTION 15.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
6 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
7 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
8 General Fund, the amount of \$25,000, for distribution to the City of
9 Gates for replacing water meters.

10 **“SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$12,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
12 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
13 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
14 Administrative Services for distribution to Marion County for the
15 Santiam Canyon Public Safety Radio System.

16 **“SECTION 17.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
17 the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
18 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
19 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
20 ministrative Services for distribution to Douglas County for the Public
21 Safety Radio System.

22 **“SECTION 18.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
23 the amount of \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
24 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
25 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
26 ministrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for North
27 Lincoln County communication and radio system infrastructure.

28 **“SECTION 19.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
29 the amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
30 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery

1 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
2 ministrative Services for distribution to Marion County for enhanced
3 broadband.

4 **“SECTION 20.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$2,400,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
6 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
7 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
8 ministrative Services for distribution to Josephine County for en-
9 hanced broadband.

10 **“SECTION 21.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$118,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
12 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
13 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Business De-
14 velopment Department for the Governor’s Recommended Budget
15 broadband investments.

16 **“SECTION 22.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
17 the amount of \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
18 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
19 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
20 ministrative Services for distribution to the unincorporated commu-
21 nity of Drakes Crossing for installing broadband and communication
22 services.

23 **“SECTION 23.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
24 the amount of \$25,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning
25 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
26 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
27 Administrative Services for distribution to Lane County for the
28 McKenzie Corridor Emergency and Community Communications
29 project.

30 **“SECTION 24.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-

1 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
2 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
3 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to electric
4 cooperatives for a grant program for homeowners for permanent
5 underground connections.

6 **“SECTION 25.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
7 the amount of \$16,500 is established for the biennium beginning July
8 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
9 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
10 ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for
11 wireless Internet hotspots at facilities in Hoodland and Boring.

12 **“SECTION 26.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
13 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
14 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
15 General Fund, the amount of \$2,100,000, for distribution to the Upper
16 McKenzie Rural Fire Protection District for rebuilding a fire station
17 and for acquiring or upgrading property, fire engines and command
18 rigs.

19 **“SECTION 27.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
20 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
21 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
22 General Fund, the amount of \$7,000,000, for distribution to the City of
23 Phoenix for the Municipal and Public Safety Complex project.

24 **“SECTION 28.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
25 ation, there is appropriated to the State Fire Marshal, for the
26 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount
27 of \$5,000,000, for the Wildland Urban Interface Fire Service Grant
28 program.

29 **“SECTION 29.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
30 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-

1 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
2 General Fund, the amount of \$30,000, for distribution to Jackson
3 County for the Emergency Operations Center and for Emergency Op-
4 erations Center computers.

5 **“SECTION 30.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
6 the amount of \$10,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
7 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
8 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
9 Administrative Services for distribution to the City of Molalla for the
10 Police Station and Emergency Operations Center.

11 **“SECTION 31.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
12 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
13 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
14 General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, for distribution to the City of
15 Talent for enhanced public safety patrols.

16 **“SECTION 32.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
17 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
18 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
19 General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, for distribution to the City of
20 Detroit for a fire station and for emergency response centers in
21 Detroit and Idanha.

22 **“SECTION 33.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
23 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
24 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
25 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to the City of
26 Detroit for ambulance positioning in the safety corridor for summer
27 season.

28 **“SECTION 34.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
30 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the

1 General Fund, the amount of \$320,000, for distribution to Lincoln
2 County for North Lincoln County public safety and enhanced sheriff
3 patrols.

4 **“SECTION 35.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
6 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
7 General Fund, the amount of \$1,800,000, for distribution to Marion
8 County for the North Fork Road Repair project.

9 **“SECTION 36.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
10 the amount of \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
11 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
12 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
13 ministrative Services for distribution to Douglas County for transpor-
14 tation infrastructure repair.

15 **“SECTION 37.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
16 the amount of \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
17 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
18 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
19 ministrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for public-
20 private road rehabilitation.

21 **“SECTION 38.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
22 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
23 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
24 General Fund, the amount of \$1,000,000, for distribution to the City of
25 Ashland for the I-5 Emergency Access Ramp project.

26 **“SECTION 39.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
27 the amount of \$100,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
28 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
29 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
30 ministrative Services for distribution to Josephine County for Happy

1 **Camp road repairs.**

2 **“SECTION 40. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
3 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
4 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
5 **General Fund, the amount of \$250,000, for distribution to Clackamas**
6 **County for emergency route planning.**

7 **“SECTION 41. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
8 **the amount of \$2,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
9 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
10 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
11 **ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for the**
12 **South Butte Creek Road Restoration project.**

13 **“SECTION 42. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
14 **the amount of \$1,700,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
15 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
16 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
17 **ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for the**
18 **South Hillockburn Road Restoration project.**

19 **“SECTION 43. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
20 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
21 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
22 **General Fund, the amount of \$23,200,000, for distribution to fire-**
23 **impacted counties for establishing the Lost Revenue Stabilization**
24 **Fund.**

25 **“SECTION 44. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
26 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
27 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
28 **General Fund, the amount of \$27,500,000, for distribution to fire-**
29 **impacted counties for planning assistance for building and planning**
30 **departments and to offset fee waiver revenue losses.**

1 **SECTION 45.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
2 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
3 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
4 General Fund, the amount of \$300,000, for distribution to Jackson
5 County for Fire District 5 to offset revenue losses.

6 **SECTION 46.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
7 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
8 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
9 General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, for distribution to the City of
10 Gates for the rural fire protection district to offset revenue losses.

11 **SECTION 47.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
12 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
13 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
14 General Fund, the amount of \$16,250, for distribution to the Silverton
15 Fire District for offsetting nonreimbursed expenses.

16 **SECTION 48.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
17 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
18 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
19 General Fund, the amount of \$1,003,000, for distribution to the Santiam
20 Service Integration Team for reimbursement for operational and dis-
21 aster case management costs.

22 **SECTION 49.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
23 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
24 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
25 General Fund, the amount of \$20,000, for distribution to the State Fair
26 Council for reimbursement for human sheltering.

27 **SECTION 50.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
28 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the
29 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount
30 of \$7,500,000, for establishing the School Stabilization Fund.

1 **SECTION 51.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
2 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
3 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
4 General Fund, the amount of \$5,650,000, for distribution to Rogue
5 Community College and Southern Oregon University for supporting
6 higher education and offsetting revenue losses.

7 **SECTION 52.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
8 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for
9 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
10 amount of \$15,000,000, for hazardous waste and structural debris
11 cleanup cost sharing.

12 **SECTION 53.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
13 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Environmental
14 Quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
15 Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, for hazardous waste and structural
16 debris cleanup cost sharing.

17 **SECTION 54.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
18 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of Emergency Management,
19 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
20 amount of \$50,000,000, for securing nonfederal cost sharing to leverage
21 Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Funds.

22 **SECTION 55.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
23 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
24 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
25 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000, for distribution to the Drakes
26 Crossing Rural Fire Protection District for cost sharing with the Fed-
27 eral Emergency Management Agency.

28 **SECTION 56.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the State Parks and Recreation De-
30 partment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General

1 Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for the Commercial District Rebuild
2 Support project and the Main Street Revitalization Program.

3 **“SECTION 57.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
4 the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
5 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
6 bond proceeds collected or received by the State Fire Marshal for in-
7 novative technologies, fire resilience and fire response.

8 **“SECTION 58.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
9 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of Emergency Management,
10 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
11 amount of \$3,230,000, for response and recovery staffing.

12 **“SECTION 59.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
13 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
14 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
15 General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, for distribution to Clackamas
16 County for staffing and materials reimbursement.

17 **“SECTION 60.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
18 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Land Conservation
19 and Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
20 General Fund, the amount of \$400,000, for planning staff.

21 **“SECTION 61.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
22 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development De-
23 partment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
24 Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for increasing municipal wildfire as-
25 sistance for local capacity.

26 **“SECTION 62.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
27 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
28 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
29 eral Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the Community Development
30 Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program.

1 **SECTION 63.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
2 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
3 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
4 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to the City of
5 Talent for emergency and recovery geographic information system
6 data management and communication capacity enhancement.

7 **SECTION 64.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
8 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
9 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
10 General Fund, the amount of \$251,000, for distribution to the City of
11 Gates for staffing and operational purposes.

12 **SECTION 65.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
13 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
14 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
15 General Fund, the amount of \$521,000, for distribution to the City of
16 Detroit for staffing and operational purposes.

17 **SECTION 66.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
18 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
19 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
20 General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, for distribution to Marion
21 County and Linn County for staffing and materials reimbursement.

22 **SECTION 67.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
23 the amount of \$300,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
24 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
25 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Housing and Commu-
26 nity Services Department for renovation, reconstruction and
27 replacement of homes, mobile homes and manufactured housing units
28 and for temporary rental and relocation assistance.

29 **SECTION 68.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
30 the amount of \$50,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning

1 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
2 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Housing and Commu-
3 nity Services Department for leveraging public funds to acquire land
4 for affordable housing units.

5 **“SECTION 69.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
6 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
7 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
8 eral Fund, the amount of \$50,000,000, for subsidizing costs related to
9 affordable housing, mobile home parks and modular, single family or
10 rental units.

11 **“SECTION 70.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
12 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
13 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
14 eral Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the Oregon Rebuilding Oregon
15 Housing Initiative.

16 **“SECTION 71.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
17 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
18 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
19 General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000, for distribution to Marion
20 County for developing the Marion County Housing Authority Santiam
21 Canyon Housing Project.

22 **“SECTION 72.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
23 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
24 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
25 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to Lane County
26 for temporary housing pads and the utility connection incentive pro-
27 gram.

28 **“SECTION 73.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of the State Fire Marshal, for
30 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the

1 amount of \$20,000,000, for a grant program to incentivize residential
2 and commercial resiliency, hardening and energy efficiency.

3 **SECTION 74.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
4 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
5 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
6 eral Fund, the amount of \$7,500,000, for rebuilding after wildfire and
7 the bulk purchasing lumber revolving loan program.

8 **SECTION 75.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
9 the amount of \$41,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
10 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
11 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the State Forestry De-
12 partment for stabilization projects, seeding for erosion control and
13 invasive species control.

14 **SECTION 76.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
15 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement
16 Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
17 Fund, the amount of \$10,750,000, for riparian and upland restoration
18 and water quality protection.

19 **SECTION 77.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
20 the amount of \$6,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
21 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
22 bond proceeds collected or received by the Department of Environ-
23 mental Quality for drinking water intake protections, repair and
24 monitoring.

25 **SECTION 78.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
26 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement
27 Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
28 Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for floodplain restoration and recon-
29 nection.

30 **SECTION 79.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-

1 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Forestry, for the
2 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount
3 of \$5,000,000, for developing tree seedling and nursery capacity and tree
4 supply for replanting.

5 **“SECTION 80.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
6 the amount of \$1,250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
7 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
8 bond proceeds collected or received by the State Department of
9 Geology and Mineral Industries for geotechnical analysis to assess
10 risks of landslides and debris flows.

11 **“SECTION 81.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
12 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for
13 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
14 amount of \$1,250,000, for assessment of cultural resources in advance
15 of recovery actions.

16 **“SECTION 82.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
17 the amount of \$500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
18 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
19 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
20 ministrative Services for distribution to Lane County for McKenzie
21 watershed recovery, water quality monitoring and geographic infor-
22 mation system analysis.

23 **“SECTION 83.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
24 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
25 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
26 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to Douglas
27 County for Archie Creek fire recreation destination repairs.

28 **“SECTION 84.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
30 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the

1 **General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to Jackson**
2 **County for the Bear Creek Greenway Restoration and Resiliency Pro-**
3 **gram.**

4 **“SECTION 85. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**
5 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
6 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**
