**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3127**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “recovery” insert “; and declaring an
2 emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 8 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$1,800,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
6 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
7 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
8 ministrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for the
9 Panther Creek Water Tank Replacement project.**

10 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$15,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
12 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
13 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
14 Administrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for the
15 Panther Creek Septic and Stormwater project.**

16 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
17 the amount of \$60,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
18 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
19 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
20 Administrative Services for distribution to Marion County for sewer
21 and septic repair and replacement.**

1 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
2 **the amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
3 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
4 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
5 **ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Detroit for the**
6 **Permanent Drinking Water System project.**

7 **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
8 **the amount of \$7,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
9 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
10 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
11 **ministrative Services for distribution to Lane County for septic repair**
12 **and replacement and for wastewater improvements for fire-impacted**
13 **riparian properties in the McKenzie River Valley.**

14 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
15 **the amount of \$20,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning**
16 **July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-**
17 **tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Department of Envi-**
18 **ronmental Quality for the Onsite Septic Repair and Replacement Loan**
19 **Program to support communities impacted by wildfire.**

20 **“SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
21 **the amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
22 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
23 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
24 **ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Talent, City of**
25 **Ashland and City of Phoenix for fire flow water line upgrades.**

26 **“SECTION 8. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
27 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
28 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
29 **General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to Lincoln**
30 **County for well repair.**

1 **“SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
2 the amount of \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
3 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
4 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
5 ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for Mount
6 Hood pump stations and installing permanent generators.

7 **“SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
8 the amount of \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
9 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
10 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
11 ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Estacada for the
12 Pump Station project.

13 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
14 the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
15 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
16 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
17 ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Talent for water
18 reservoir replacement to ensure adequate fire flow.

19 **“SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
20 the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
21 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
22 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
23 ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Glide for Water
24 Association upgrades.

25 **“SECTION 13.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
26 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
27 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
28 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to the City of
29 Phoenix for Charlotte Ann Water District Disbanding Transition costs.

30 **“SECTION 14.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-

1 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
2 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
3 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to Jackson
4 County and Douglas County for Private Water System Assistance.

5 **“SECTION 15.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
6 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
7 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
8 General Fund, the amount of \$25,000, for distribution to the City of
9 Gates for replacing water meters.

10 **“SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$12,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
12 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
13 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
14 Administrative Services for distribution to Marion County for the
15 Santiam Canyon Public Safety Radio System.

16 **“SECTION 17.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
17 the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
18 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
19 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
20 ministrative Services for distribution to Douglas County for the Public
21 Safety Radio System.

22 **“SECTION 18.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
23 the amount of \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
24 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
25 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
26 ministrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for North
27 Lincoln County communication and radio system infrastructure.

28 **“SECTION 19.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
29 the amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
30 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery

1 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
2 ministrative Services for distribution to Marion County for enhanced
3 broadband.

4 **“SECTION 20.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$2,400,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
6 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
7 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
8 ministrative Services for distribution to Josephine County for en-
9 hanced broadband.

10 **“SECTION 21.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
12 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
13 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
14 ministrative Services for distribution to the unincorporated commu-
15 nity of Drakes Crossing for installing broadband and communication
16 services.

17 **“SECTION 22.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
18 the amount of \$25,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning
19 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
20 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of
21 Administrative Services for distribution to Lane County for the
22 McKenzie Corridor Emergency and Community Communications
23 project.

24 **“SECTION 23.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
25 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
26 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
27 General Fund, the amount of \$10,000,000, for distribution to electric
28 cooperatives and municipal electricity providers for a grant program
29 for homeowners for permanent underground connections.

30 **“SECTION 24.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,

1 the amount of \$16,500 is established for the biennium beginning July
2 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
3 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
4 ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for
5 wireless Internet hotspots at facilities in Hoodland and Boring.

6 **SECTION 25.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
7 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
8 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
9 General Fund, the amount of \$2,100,000, for distribution to the Upper
10 McKenzie Rural Fire Protection District for rebuilding a fire station
11 and for acquiring or upgrading property, fire engines and command
12 rigs.

13 **SECTION 26.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
14 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
15 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
16 General Fund, the amount of \$7,000,000, for distribution to the City of
17 Phoenix for the Municipal and Public Safety Complex project.

18 **SECTION 27.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
19 ation, there is appropriated to the State Fire Marshal, for the
20 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount
21 of \$5,000,000, for the Wildland Urban Interface Fire Service Grant
22 program.

23 **SECTION 28.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
24 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
25 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
26 General Fund, the amount of \$30,000, for distribution to Jackson
27 County for the Emergency Operations Center and for Emergency Op-
28 erations Center computers.

29 **SECTION 29.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
30 the amount of \$8,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July

1 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
2 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
3 ministrative Services for distribution to the City of Molalla for the
4 Police Station and Emergency Operations Center.

5 **“SECTION 30.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
6 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
7 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
8 General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, for distribution to the City of
9 Talent for enhanced public safety patrols.

10 **“SECTION 31.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
11 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
12 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
13 General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, for distribution to the City of
14 Detroit for a fire station and for emergency response centers in
15 Detroit and Idanha.

16 **“SECTION 32.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
17 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
18 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
19 General Fund, the amount of \$320,000, for distribution to Lincoln
20 County for North Lincoln County public safety and enhanced sheriff
21 patrols.

22 **“SECTION 33.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
23 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
24 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
25 General Fund, the amount of \$1,800,000, for distribution to Marion
26 County for the North Fork Road Repair project.

27 **“SECTION 34.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
28 the amount of \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
29 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
30 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-

1 **ministrative Services for distribution to Douglas County for transpor-**
2 **tation infrastructure repair.**

3 **“SECTION 35. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
4 **the amount of \$1,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
5 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
6 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
7 **ministrative Services for distribution to Lincoln County for public-**
8 **private road rehabilitation.**

9 **“SECTION 36. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
10 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
11 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
12 **General Fund, the amount of \$1,000,000, for distribution to the City of**
13 **Ashland for the I-5 Emergency Access Ramp project.**

14 **“SECTION 37. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
15 **the amount of \$100,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
16 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
17 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
18 **ministrative Services for distribution to Josephine County for Happy**
19 **Camp road repairs.**

20 **“SECTION 38. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
21 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-**
22 **tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the**
23 **General Fund, the amount of \$250,000, for distribution to Clackamas**
24 **County for emergency route planning.**

25 **“SECTION 39. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
26 **the amount of \$2,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**
27 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
28 **bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-**
29 **ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for the**
30 **South Butte Creek Road Restoration project.**

1 **SECTION 40.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
2 the amount of \$1,700,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
3 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
4 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
5 ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for the
6 South Hillockburn Road Restoration project.

7 **SECTION 41.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
8 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
9 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
10 General Fund, the amount of \$23,200,000, for distribution to fire-
11 impacted counties for establishing the Lost Revenue Stabilization
12 Fund.

13 **SECTION 42.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
14 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
15 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
16 General Fund, the amount of \$300,000, for distribution to Jackson
17 County for Fire District 5 to offset revenue losses.

18 **SECTION 43.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
19 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
20 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
21 General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, for distribution to the City of
22 Gates for the rural fire protection district to offset revenue losses.

23 **SECTION 44.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
24 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
25 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
26 General Fund, the amount of \$16,250, for distribution to the Silverton
27 Fire District for offsetting nonreimbursed expenses.

28 **SECTION 45.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
30 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the

1 General Fund, the amount of \$1,003,000, for distribution to the Santiam
2 Service Integration Team for operational and disaster case manage-
3 ment costs.

4 **“SECTION 46.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
6 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
7 General Fund, the amount of \$20,000, for distribution to the State Fair
8 Council for reimbursement for livestock sheltering.

9 **“SECTION 47.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
10 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the
11 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount
12 of \$7,500,000, for establishing the School Stabilization Fund.

13 **“SECTION 48.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
14 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
15 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
16 General Fund, the amount of \$5,650,000, for distribution to Rogue
17 Community College and Southern Oregon University for supporting
18 higher education and offsetting revenue losses.

19 **“SECTION 49.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
20 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for
21 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
22 amount of \$15,000,000, for hazardous waste and structural debris
23 cleanup cost sharing.

24 **“SECTION 50.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
25 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Environmental
26 Quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
27 Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, for hazardous waste and structural
28 debris cleanup cost sharing.

29 **“SECTION 51.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
30 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of Emergency Management,

1 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
2 amount of \$50,000,000, for securing nonfederal cost sharing to leverage
3 Federal Emergency Management Agency Hazard Mitigation Funds.

4 **“SECTION 52.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
6 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
7 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000, for distribution to the Drakes
8 Crossing Rural Fire Protection District for cost sharing with the Fed-
9 eral Emergency Management Agency.

10 **“SECTION 53.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
11 ation, there is appropriated to the State Parks and Recreation De-
12 partment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
13 Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for the Commercial District Rebuild
14 Support project and the Main Street Revitalization Program.

15 **“SECTION 54.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
16 the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
17 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
18 bond proceeds collected or received by the State Fire Marshal for in-
19 novative technologies, fire resilience and fire response.

20 **“SECTION 55.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
21 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of Emergency Management,
22 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
23 amount of \$3,230,000, for response and recovery staffing.

24 **“SECTION 56.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
25 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
26 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
27 General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, for distribution to Clackamas
28 County for staffing and materials reimbursement.

29 **“SECTION 57.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
30 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Land Conservation

1 and Development, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
2 General Fund, the amount of \$400,000, for planning staff.

3 **SECTION 58.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
4 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Business Development De-
5 partment, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
6 Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for increasing municipal wildfire as-
7 sistance for local capacity.

8 **SECTION 59.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
9 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
10 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
11 eral Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the Community Development
12 Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program.

13 **SECTION 60.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
14 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
15 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
16 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to the City of
17 Talent for emergency and recovery geographic information system
18 data management and communication capacity enhancement.

19 **SECTION 61.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
20 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
21 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
22 General Fund, the amount of \$251,000, for distribution to the City of
23 Gates for staffing and operational purposes.

24 **SECTION 62.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
25 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
26 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
27 General Fund, the amount of \$521,000, for distribution to the City of
28 Detroit for staffing and operational purposes.

29 **SECTION 63.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
30 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-

1 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
2 General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, for distribution to Marion
3 County and Linn County for staffing and materials reimbursement.

4 **“SECTION 64.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$300,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
6 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
7 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Housing and Commu-
8 nity Services Department for renovation, reconstruction and
9 replacement of homes, mobile homes and manufactured housing units
10 and for temporary rental and relocation assistance.

11 **“SECTION 65.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
12 the amount of \$50,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
13 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
14 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the Housing and Commu-
15 nity Services Department for leveraging public funds to acquire land
16 for affordable housing units.

17 **“SECTION 66.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
18 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
19 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
20 eral Fund, the amount of \$50,000,000, for subsidizing costs related to
21 affordable housing, mobile home parks and modular, single family or
22 rental units.

23 **“SECTION 67.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
24 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
25 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
26 eral Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the Oregon Rebuilding Oregon
27 Housing Initiative.

28 **“SECTION 68.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
30 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the

1 General Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000, for distribution to Marion
2 County for developing the Marion County Housing Authority Santiam
3 Canyon Housing Project.

4 **“SECTION 69.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
6 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
7 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to Lane County
8 for temporary housing pads and the utility connection incentive pro-
9 gram.

10 **“SECTION 70.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
11 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of the State Fire Marshal, for
12 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
13 amount of \$20,000,000, for a grant program to incentivize residential
14 and commercial resiliency, hardening and energy efficiency.

15 **“SECTION 71.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
16 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
17 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the Gen-
18 eral Fund, the amount of \$7,500,000, for rebuilding after wildfire and
19 the bulk purchasing lumber revolving loan program.

20 **“SECTION 72.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
21 the amount of \$41,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning
22 July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lot-
23 tery bond proceeds collected or received by the State Forestry De-
24 partment for stabilization projects, seeding for erosion control and
25 invasive species control.

26 **“SECTION 73.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
27 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement
28 Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
29 Fund, the amount of \$10,750,000, for riparian and upland restoration
30 and water quality protection.

1 **“SECTION 74.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
2 the amount of \$6,500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
3 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
4 bond proceeds collected or received by the Department of Environ-
5 mental Quality for drinking water intake protections, repair and
6 monitoring in regions of this state impacted by wildfire.

7 **“SECTION 75.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
8 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement
9 Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General
10 Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for floodplain restoration and recon-
11 nection in regions of this state impacted by wildfire.

12 **“SECTION 76.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
13 ation, there is appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the
14 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount
15 of \$5,000,000, for developing tree seedling and nursery capacity and tree
16 supply for replanting in regions of this state impacted by wildfire.

17 **“SECTION 77.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
18 the amount of \$1,250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
19 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
20 bond proceeds collected or received by the State Department of
21 Geology and Mineral Industries for geotechnical analysis to assess
22 risks of landslides and debris flows in regions of this state impacted
23 by wildfire.

24 **“SECTION 78.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
25 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Transportation, for
26 the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the
27 amount of \$1,250,000, for assessment of cultural resources in advance
28 of recovery actions in regions of this state impacted by wildfire.

29 **“SECTION 79.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
30 the amount of \$500,000 is established for the biennium beginning July

1 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
2 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
3 ministrative Services for distribution to the Eugene Water and Elec-
4 tric Board for McKenzie watershed recovery, water quality monitoring
5 and geographic information system analysis.

6 **“SECTION 80.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
7 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
8 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
9 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to Douglas
10 County for Archie Creek fire recreation destination repairs.

11 **“SECTION 81.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
12 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
13 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
14 General Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000, for distribution to Jackson
15 County for the Bear Creek Greenway Restoration and Resiliency Pro-
16 gram.

17 **“SECTION 82.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
18 the amount of \$3,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
19 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
20 bond proceeds collected or received by the Oregon Department of Ad-
21 ministrative Services for distribution to Clackamas County for en-
22 hanced broadband.

23 **“SECTION 83.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
24 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
25 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
26 General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, for distribution to the Eugene
27 Water and Electric Board for revegetation of private properties outside
28 the Department of Transportation right of way adjacent to the High-
29 way 126 corridor.

30 **“SECTION 84.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-

1 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
2 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
3 General Fund, the amount of \$4,000,000, for distribution to the Eugene
4 Water and Electric Board for restoration and targeted acquisition of
5 high priority McKenzie River riparian and floodplain properties, in-
6 cluding tribal consultation services.

7 **SECTION 85.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
8 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
9 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
10 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to the McKenzie
11 Fire and Rescue Fire District for constructing a disaster relief logistics
12 center.

13 **SECTION 86.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
14 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
15 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
16 General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, for distribution to Marion
17 County for enhanced patrol and overtime by the sheriff's office.

18 **SECTION 87.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
19 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
20 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
21 General Fund, the amount of \$150,000, for distribution to Linn County
22 for enhanced patrol and overtime by the sheriff's office.

23 **SECTION 88.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
24 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
25 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
26 General Fund, the amount of \$78,129.92, for distribution to Crawford
27 Electric for installing temporary power poles in the Santiam Canyon.

28 **SECTION 89.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the
30 biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount

1 of \$12,000,000, for developing the ALERTWildfire system.

2 **“SECTION 90.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
3 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administra-
4 tive Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the
5 General Fund, the following amounts, for distribution to the following
6 entities, for the following purposes:

7 **“(1) To Lane County, \$455,319, for staffing for building and planning**
8 **departments;**

9 **“(2) To Lane County, \$2,359,085, for offsetting fee waiver revenue**
10 **losses;**

11 **“(3) To Linn County, \$275,000, for staffing for building and planning**
12 **departments;**

13 **“(4) To Linn County, \$250,000, for offsetting fee waiver revenue**
14 **losses;**

15 **“(5) To Lincoln County, \$190,000, for staffing for building and plan-**
16 **ning departments;**

17 **“(6) To Lincoln County, \$476,260, for offsetting fee waiver revenue**
18 **losses;**

19 **“(7) To Douglas County, \$750,000, for staffing for building and**
20 **planning departments and offsetting fee waiver revenue losses;**

21 **“(8) To Marion County, \$800,000, for staffing for building and plan-**
22 **ning departments;**

23 **“(9) To Marion County, \$1,700,000, for offsetting fee waiver revenue**
24 **losses;**

25 **“(10) To Clackamas County, \$455,629, for offsetting fee waiver reve-**
26 **nue losses;**

27 **“(11) To Jackson County, \$710,000, for staffing for building and**
28 **planning departments;**

29 **“(12) To Jackson County, \$9,662,852, for offsetting fee waiver reve-**
30 **nue losses;**

1 **“(13) To the City of Talent, \$280,000, for staffing for building and**
2 **planning departments;**

3 **“(14) To the City of Talent, \$5,905,690, for offsetting fee waiver rev-**
4 **enue losses;**

5 **“(15) To the City of Phoenix, \$677,755, for staffing for building and**
6 **planning departments; and**

7 **“(16) To the City of Phoenix, \$2,560,000, for offsetting fee waiver**
8 **revenue losses.**

9 **“SECTION 91. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**
10 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
11 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**
