PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 649

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "degree;" delete the rest of the line and
- 2 insert "amending ORS 163.425; and repealing ORS 163.426.".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 26 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 163.425 is amended to read:
- 5 "163.425. (1) A person commits the crime of sexual abuse in the second degree when:
- 7 "(a) The person subjects another person to sexual intercourse, oral or
- 8 anal sexual intercourse or, except as provided in ORS 163.412, penetration
- 9 of the vagina, anus or penis with any object other than the penis or mouth
- of the actor and the victim does not consent thereto; or
- "(b)(A) The person violates ORS 163.415 (1)(a)(B);
- "(B) The person is 21 years of age or older; and
- "(C) At any time before the commission of the offense, the person was the victim's coach [as defined in ORS 163.426] or teacher.
- 15 "(2) Sexual abuse in the second degree is a Class C felony.
- "(3) Notwithstanding ORS 137.669 and 137.671, the sentencing guidelines of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission do not apply to a sentence imposed under this section. Upon the conviction of a defendant under this section, the sentencing court shall consider any relevant aggravating or mitigating evidence offered by the defendant or the prosecuting attorney and may impose any sentence otherwise

- 2 "(4) As used in this section:
- "(a) 'Coach' means a person who instructs or trains an individual
 or members of a team in a sport.
- 5 "(b) 'Teacher' means an employee of a school or school district who 6 has direct responsibility for the instruction of students.
- ⁷ "SECTION 2. ORS 163.426 is repealed.".
