**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2337**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 13 through 45.

2 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 11 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) The advisory committee described in ORS 413.161**
4 **(2) shall commission a study of the collection of race, ethnicity, lan-**
5 **guage and disability status data of Oregonians. The study shall in-**
6 **clude:**

7 **“(a) What state agencies collect the data;**

8 **“(b) An inventory, by state agency, of databases used to compile the**
9 **data;**

10 **“(c) The ability readiness of the data systems used by the state**
11 **agencies listed in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection to collect**
12 **race, ethnicity, language and disability status data; and**

13 **“(d) Defining for the data systems described in paragraph (c) of this**
14 **subsection:**

15 **“(A) What it would cost to collect race, ethnicity, language and**
16 **disability status data;**

17 **“(B) Which data systems are able to be upgraded; and**

18 **“(C) Which data systems are a priority for upgrading, based on gaps**
19 **in race, ethnicity, language and disability status data collection.**

20 **“(2) No later than July 1, 2023, the Oregon Health Authority shall**
21 **report to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided in ORS**

1 **192.245, on the results and findings of the study described in subsection**
2 **(1) of this section.**

3 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall provide grants**
4 **to one or more entities to operate two mobile health units as a pilot**
5 **program. Eligibility requirements for grants must be consistent with**
6 **the authority’s 2020-2024 State Health Improvement Plan, Healthier**
7 **Together. An entity receiving a grant must demonstrate the ability**
8 **of the entity to serve communities with histories of poor health out-**
9 **comes.**

10 **“(2) Pilot mobile health units funded by grants described in sub-**
11 **section (1) of this section must engage in an assessment of the com-**
12 **munities served to inform the potential expansion of the pilot program**
13 **statewide.**

14 **“(3) The authority shall study the feasibility of expanding mobile**
15 **health units throughout the state. In conducting the study, the au-**
16 **thority shall engage providers, members of coordinated care organ-**
17 **izations, medical assistance recipients and other community members.**
18 **The study shall include:**

19 **“(a) An environmental scan of Oregon;**

20 **“(b) A needs assessment of the collective needs of underserved areas**
21 **of the state;**

22 **“(c) The identification and development of regional parameters**
23 **where mobile health units will operate;**

24 **“(d) The identification and development of a mobile health unit**
25 **model;**

26 **“(e) An analysis of services to be provided by mobile health units;**

27 **“(f) The identification of opportunities to leverage matching federal**
28 **funds;**

29 **“(g) An analysis of staff and resources needed for statewide mobile**
30 **health units;**

1 **“(h) A financial analysis; and**
2 **“(i) How to ensure the authority’s goals for equity and inclusion**
3 **are met.**

4 **“(4) The authority shall provide an interim report to the Legislative**
5 **Assembly, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, no later than De-**
6 **cember 31, 2023, and a final report no later than June 30, 2024, on the**
7 **implementation of the pilot program described in subsection (1) of this**
8 **section and the findings of the study described in subsection (3) of this**
9 **section. The final report shall include recommendations for imple-**
10 **menting a statewide mobile health unit pilot program.”.**

11 In line 21, delete “establish and” and insert “develop recommendations
12 on how to”.

13 In line 22, after “programs” insert “, across all relevant state agencies,”.

14 Delete line 29 and insert “November 1, 2022.”.

15 Delete lines 30 through 45.

16 Delete page 4.

17 On page 5, delete line 1 and insert:

18 **“SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
19 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, out of the**
20 **General Fund, the amount of \$2,000,000, which may be expended for**
21 **carrying out section 3 of this 2021 Act. This appropriation is contin-**
22 **uously available to the authority until the earlier of the date the ap-**
23 **propriation is expended for carrying out section 3 of this 2021 Act or**
24 **January 2, 2024. Moneys that are not expended for carrying out section**
25 **3 of this 2021 Act by January 2, 2024 shall revert to the General Fund.**

26 **“SECTION 6. Sections 2 and 3 of this 2021 Act are repealed on July**
27 **1, 2024.”.**

28 In line 2, delete “14” and insert “7”.

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
