**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5515**

1 Delete lines 5 through 26 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Department of**
3 **Energy, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General**
4 **Fund, the amount of \$80,092 for oversight of radioactive waste disposal.**

5 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
6 **the amount of \$31,011,546 is established for the biennium beginning**
7 **July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,**
8 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
9 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
10 **State Department of Energy.**

11 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
12 **the amount of \$3,022,570 is established for the biennium beginning July**
13 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
14 **moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-**
15 **opment Fund to the State Department of Energy for debt service for**
16 **the energy efficiency and sustainable technology loan program, and for**
17 **the public schools grant program.**

18 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
19 **the amount of \$3,123,736 is established for the biennium beginning July**
20 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal**
21 **funds collected or received by the State Department of Energy.**

1 **“SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, the following**
2 **expenditures by the State Department of Energy are not limited:**

3 **“(1) Expenditures for loans for small scale local energy projects; and**

4 **“(2) Expenditures for debt service.**

5 **“SECTION 6. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**
6 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
7 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**
