**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 5539**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 27 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
4 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
5 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**
6 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
7 **cluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in section 2**
8 **of this 2021 Act, collected or received by the Department of State**
9 **Lands, for the following purposes:**

- 10 (1) Common School Fund
11 programs..... \$ 40,779,060
12 (2) Submerged Lands
13 Enhancement Fund..... \$ 200,000
14 (3) South Slough National
15 Estuarine Research
16 Reserve operations..... \$ 2,642,051
17 (4) Capital improvements \$ 549,056
18 (5) Oregon Wetlands
19 Revolving Fund \$ 2,048,739

20 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
21 **the amount of \$5,249,000 is established for the biennium beginning July**

1 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-
2 partment of State Lands from the Portland Harbor Cleanup Fund es-
3 tablished by ORS 274.064.

4 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
5 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
6 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**
7 **funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands for the**
8 **following purposes:**

- 9 (1) South Slough National
10 Estuarine Research
11 Reserve operations..... \$ 2,738,001
- 12 (2) Common School Fund
13 programs..... \$ 195,954

14 **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures**
15 **by the Department of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges,**
16 **unclaimed property finders fees and State Treasurer charges for**
17 **investment-related transactions are not limited.**

18 **“SECTION 5. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**
19 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
20 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**
