**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5025**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
4 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
5 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**
6 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
7 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
8 **State Parks and Recreation Department, for the following purposes:**

- 9 (1) Director’s office..... \$ 941,725
10 (2) Central services..... \$ 20,114,569
11 (3) Parks development..... \$ 4,983,803
12 (4) Direct services..... \$ 71,291,958
13 (5) Community support
14 and grants..... \$ 18,363,616

15 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
16 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
17 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from lottery**
18 **moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to the**
19 **State Parks and Recreation Department, for the following purposes:**

- 20 (1) Director’s office..... \$ 1,521,609
21 (2) Central services..... \$ 19,954,304

- 1 (3) Parks development..... \$ 16,211,364
- 2 (4) Direct services..... \$ 59,258,532
- 3 (5) Community support
- 4 and grants..... \$ 19,865,281

5 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
6 **the amount of \$3,776,660 is established for the biennium beginning July**
7 **1, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**
8 **moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-**
9 **opment Fund to the State Parks and Recreation Department for the**
10 **payment of debt service.**

11 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
12 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
13 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**
14 **funds collected or received by the State Parks and Recreation Depart-**
15 **ment for the following purposes:**

- 16 (1) Parks development..... \$ 1,892,853
- 17 (2) Direct services..... \$ 2,415,941
- 18 (3) Community support
- 19 and grants..... \$ 18,493,835

20 **“SECTION 5. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**
21 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
22 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**
