PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 58

- On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete "; and declaring an emer-".
- 3 Delete line 3.
- Delete lines 12 through 25 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:
- "SECTION 3. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality may impose a surcharge of four percent on each fee or invoice generated using the environmental data management system.
- "(2) Notwithstanding the surcharge percentage rate described in 9 subsection (1) of this section, the department shall reduce the sur-10 charge percentage rate below four percent for a biennium if the de-11 partment determines that the reduced surcharge percentage rate will 12 be sufficient to defray the costs to the department of licensing and 13 hosting the environmental data management system during the 14 biennium. If the department determines that a reduced surcharge 15 percentage rate will be sufficient, the department shall issue an order 16 on or before January 1 of the odd-numbered year setting forth the 17 reduced surcharge percentage rate for the following biennium. If the 18 department reduces the surcharge percentage rate under this sub-19 section, the surcharge percentage rate shall revert to four percent af-20 ter the end of the biennium, unless the department issues an 21

additional order as provided in this subsection.

"(3) If the department reduces the surcharge percentage rate as described in subsection (2) of this section, the department shall notify all persons with an active account within the environmental data management system of the reduced surcharge percentage rate.

"(4) Surcharge moneys collected by the department under this section shall be included in the fee or invoice payment associated with the surcharge and initially deposited into the same fund or account as the fee or invoice payment associated with the surcharge. The department shall periodically transfer all surcharge moneys from the funds or accounts into which surcharge moneys were initially deposited to the Environmental Data Management System Fund established under section 4 of this 2021 Act.".
