¹⁵ "<u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS chapter 461, ¹⁶ during the time period beginning on the effective date of this 2021 Act ¹⁷ and ending on January 2, 2023, the Oregon State Lottery Commission ¹⁸ may not authorize, and the Oregon State Lottery may not implement, ¹⁹ any lottery games playable on a mobile device, personal computer or ²⁰ other personal electronic device that were not authorized or imple-²¹ mented before the effective date of this 2021 Act. "(2) Nothing in this section prohibits the Oregon State Lottery from
entering into new contracts with video lottery game retailers, as defined in ORS 461.217, or carrying out existing contracts with video
lottery game retailers.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
date on which the 2021 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative
