2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Business De-**  
4 **velopment Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out**  
5 **of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following pur-**  
6 **poses:**

- 7 (1) Oregon Arts Commission..... \$ 4,085,556  
8 (2) Business, innovation and  
9 trade..... \$ 8,604,743  
10 (3) Debt service ..... \$ 70,193,654  
11 (4) Infrastructure..... \$ 12,648,000

12 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
13 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
14 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**  
15 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**  
16 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**  
17 **Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:**

- 18 (1) Business, innovation  
19 and trade..... \$ 21,536,912  
20 (2) Infrastructure..... \$464,422,405  
21 (3) Operations..... \$ 3,312,509

1 (4) Arts and Cultural Trust ..... \$ 11,197,747

2 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
3 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
4 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from lottery**  
5 **moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-**  
6 **opment Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for**  
7 **the following purposes:**

- 8 (1) Business, innovation
- 9 and trade..... \$ 77,234,697
- 10 (2) Operations..... \$ 9,655,570
- 11 (3) Oregon Film and Video Office .. \$ 1,307,330
- 12 (4) Lottery bond debt service..... \$ 50,379,539
- 13 (5) Infrastructure..... \$ 2,798,735

14 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
15 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
16 **1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**  
17 **funds collected or received by the Oregon Business Development De-**  
18 **partment, for the following purposes:**

- 19 (1) Business, innovation
- 20 and trade..... \$ 28,256,787
- 21 (2) Infrastructure..... \$ 54,808,506
- 22 (3) Operations..... \$ 250,176
- 23 (4) Arts..... \$ 2,119,144

24 **“SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, expenditures**  
25 **by the Oregon Business Development Department are not limited for:**

26 **“(1) Loans from the following funds:**

27 **“(a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon**  
28 **Entrepreneurial Development Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit En-**  
29 **hancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and Small Business Expansion Loan**  
30 **Fund (ORS 285B.133).**

1       **“(b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS**  
2 **285B.563), Marine Navigation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon**  
3 **Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708), Safe Drinking Water Revolving**  
4 **Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213) and Brownfields Redevelopment Fund (ORS**  
5 **285A.188).**

6       **“(2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds**  
7 **and general obligation bonds.**

8       **“SECTION 6. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
9 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
10 **declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect July 1, 2021.”.**
