- 2 "(c) Federal matching funds received under 45 C.F.R. 1356.60(c); and
- 3 "(d) Miscellaneous revenues and receipts of the commission.
- 4 "(3) All gifts, grants or contributions accepted by the commission under
- 5 ORS 151.216 shall be deposited in a separate subaccount created in the Public
- 6 Defense Services Account to be used by the commission for the purpose for
- 7 which the gift, grant or contribution was given or granted.
- 8 "SECTION 7b. If Senate Bill 817 becomes law, the amendments to
- 9 ORS 151.225 by section 7a of this 2021 Act become operative on January
- 10 **1, 2022.**".
