

The eviction moratorium is keeping my family off the streets, for now. I have three young boys--1.5, 3, and 5 years old--home with me and the past months have been really stressful. We haven't been able to work since COVID and have fallen behind thousands in rent. We've had to accrue other debt and haven't even been able to pay our water and electric bill. I'm trying to do everything I can to help my family get by, but even so we're running out of food for the kids at the end of the month. The pandemic has been really hard for my sons. My oldest is struggling with remote kindergarten and my middle son is autistic. Having us all home has made me especially grateful that he can have his own room. Without the moratorium, all five of us would be living on top of each other in our van. We have nowhere else to go.
