This bill would grant validation to hard of hearing or deaf Oregonians and make sure that police officers are aware of their situation without escalation.

This bill will directly impact the fear and anxiety that hard of hearing or deaf Oregonians feel when driving and will discourage any misconceptions that police officers may have during routine interactions.
