I oppose HB 2133, Oregon fingerprinting is enough, the legislator treats its citizen like we just 'Escaped Alcatraz'. "Readable", really? Palm prints, photograph and unique arrest fingerprint control number of persons arrested for an offense other than a felony or misdemeanor. I oppose all printing except fingerprinting of arrested and booked in city or county of inmates.

Revenue Expenses: New Equipment Purchase, Installation of Equipment, Resources to operate the equipment, Equipment training, Cost of additional employment expenses as HB 2133 as currently written.
