My name is Evelyn Guzman and I am an Oregon Field Organizer with Forward Together Action. At Forward Together we believe that our communities should have access to the rights, recognition, and resources that our families need to thrive which is why we are in full support of HB 2358.

HB 2358, is one step forward to addressing the inequity that exists in Oregon by creating economic stability to a class of workers who have been excluded from basic labor standards such as minimum wage, collective bargaining rights, and overtime pay. Our farmworker community often endure some of the toughest working conditions as is, but 2020 showed us how often unequipped and exposed to harsh working conditions they are without the ability that many of us have to work from home.
